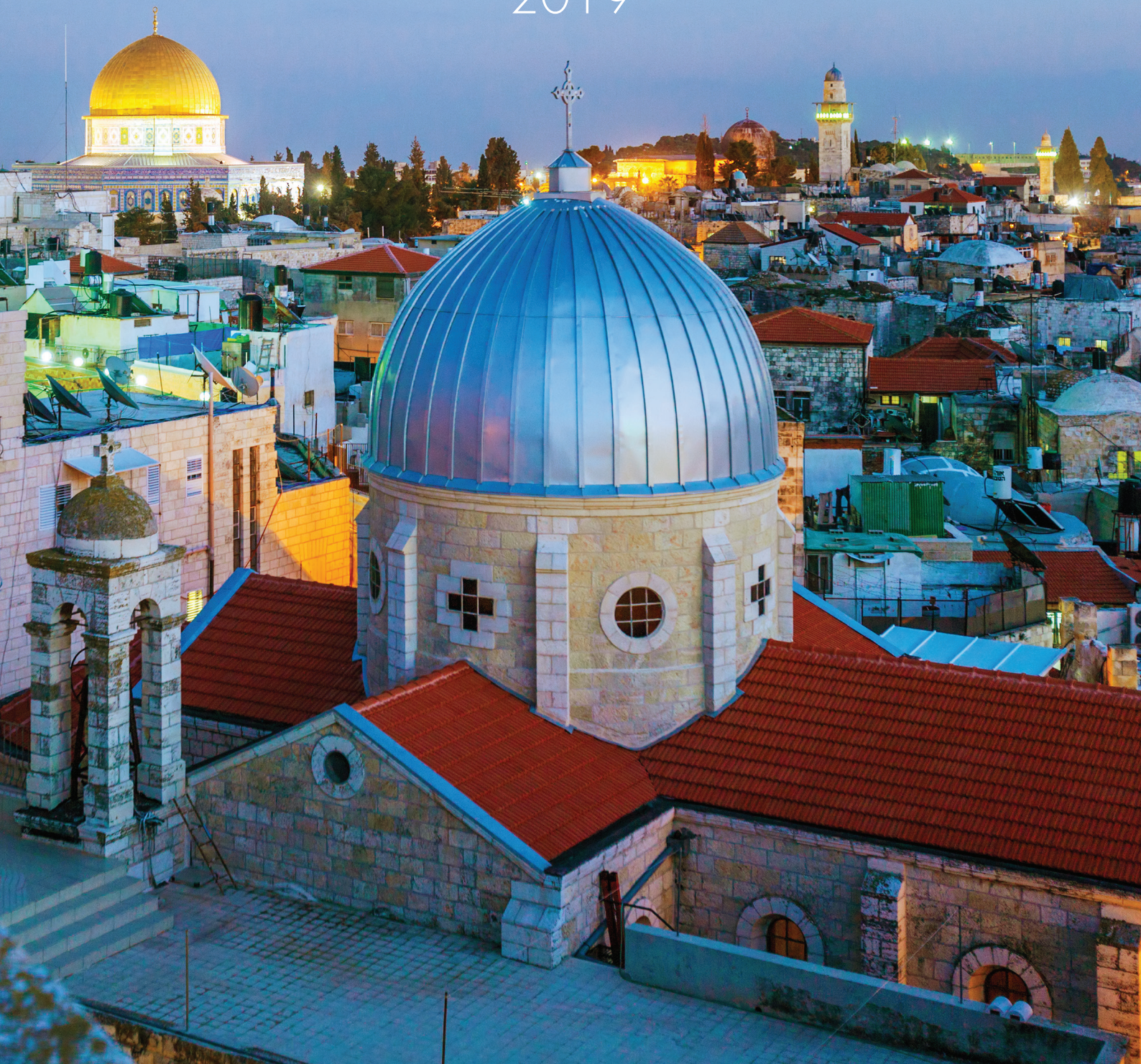

DAY 1 Depart from Sydney

DAY 2 AMMAN

Arrive at Amman airport and be met by our airport staff who will help you clear immigration and collect your baggage. Then board the transfer and head to the city of Amman, the capital of Jordan where your tour will begin. Visit the Citadel which was used by the Umayyad Islamic rulers and then continue on to visit the Roman city of Jerash exploring The City of a Thousand Columns, the Amphitheatre and Cathedral.

DAY 3 AMMAN - PETRA

After breakfast, you will board the coach to visit the place where John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod at the request of his step-daughter and dancer Salome. Then transfer to Mt. Nebo, where Moses died and was buried in an adjacent valley (Genesis 31:34). Here Moses, shortly before his own death, stood and commanded humankind to heed God and to "choose life" (Deuteronomy 30:19). Continue to visit Madaba and experience the world's finest collections of Byzantine Mosaic art including the map of Jerusalem and the Holy Land dating back to 6th Century AD.

DAY 4 PETRA - AMMAN

After breakfast, you will board the transfer to visit the old city of Petra, starting by riding on horseback to the entrance of The Siq. This is the main entrance to the ancient Nabatean city of Petra, where you will then walk into The Siq through the massive natural split in the rock. Continue along it is winding rock canal between overhanging cliffs that seem the meet more than 300 feet overhead. At the end of The Siq we come to the Treasury (al-Khazneh), which was designed to impress and, two thousand years on, the effect is undiminished. Carved out of the solid rock from the side of the mountain, is nearly 140 feet high and 90 feet wide.

DAY 5 AMMAN - JERUSALEM

You depart Amman in the morning and arrive at the Alenby Bridge to cross into Israel, the Promised Land. As you drive by Jericho you will see Mount Temptation where Jesus was on trial by the Devil for 40 days and nights. From here you will travel south and take the cable car from the eastern side of Masada to the peak. Here your guide will treat you to the history of the famous zealot stand. Afterwards you will visit Ein Gedi, "Spring of the Goat," an oasis on the western shore of the Dead Sea. This is where King David hid from Saul, and where God defeated the enemies of the Israelites by praise and worship led by King Jehoshaphat. (1 Sam 23:29; 24 Song of Songs 1:14). Due to its warm climate and abundant supply of water, the site developed a reputation for its fragrant plants and date palm groves. Then you travel to Jerusalem, on the way you will stop at the Dead Sea for a short float on the Dead Sea waters. Upon arrival in Jerusalem you will check into your accommodation and enjoy dinner.

DAY 6 JERUSALEM

This morning you start your tour at the Mount of Olives view point. From here you will see the entire Old City, Mount Moriah and the Temple Mount. From the site of the ascension of Jesus you will walk down along the Palm Sunday Road and reach the Garden of Gethsemane, how many have wished to be whisked back in time to get a glimpse of our Lord or hear His voice if only for a moment? Walking between the ancient olive trees, reading the scriptures of Jesus' prayer and taking time for personal reflection is important here. Next, we arrive at Mount Zion and here we will visit the "Upper Room" where the disciple whom Jesus loved laid his head on His breast and where later Thomas cried; "my Lord & my God." Next is the traditional site of the tomb of King David. You will enter the old city and walk through the Jewish Quarter, see the Roman Cardo, the Broad Wall and the Western Wall.

DAY 7 JERUSALEM

An interesting and educational day of touring awaits you today. To begin, you will visit the Children's Exhibit of Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum, and then onto the scale model of the ancient city of Jerusalem. Your guide will walk you through the model, measuring 2,000 sq mt, depicts Jerusalem at the time of the second temple and enables a glimpse of biblical times as well as the architecture and décor of the Temple. Next, you visit the Shrine of the Book, housing the authentic Dead Sea scrolls. Your next stop will be at the Knesset (Parliament building) to see the Giant Menorah standing across from the impressive building. Later you will visit the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus cured a cripple. From there you move on to the Judgment Hall of Pilate, hear of those who conspired against Him and are reminded of His brutal beating and humiliation. While walking along the Via Dolorosa, we are reminded of His way of suffering, view the Church of the Sepulcher before we arrive at the climax of our tour - the Garden Tomb. Your faith, that blessed hope and communion with Christ, will take on a tremendous new meaning today.

DAY 8 JERUSALEM

This morning you will drive over to Bethlehem where we will visit the site of the Nativity of our Lord. Later we will reach the area called "the Shepherds fields" this where the shepherds saw the Bethlehem star. Then back to Jerusalem to the village of Ein Karem the birth place of John the Baptist, we will visit the fountain and St. John's Church. Next is an exciting visit to one of the most beautiful markets in Jerusalem called Machne Yehuda.

DAY 9 JERUSALEM - TIBERIUS

Today you leave Jerusalem and travel north. Your first visit will be to Jericho where you will see the ancient Tell es-Sultan, the oldest town in the world, where you will explore the Monastery of Temptation built over the cliffs of Mt. Temptation, Elisha's spring and the Sycamore Tree. Continue north along the Jordan Valley highway to your next stop at Beth Shean to view the spectacular Roman and Byzantine ruins. The bodies of King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls (1 Samuel 31:10-12) in Beth Shean after they were defeated by the Philistines. Now you arrive at Yardenit the Baptismal site on the banks of the Jordan River, here you will have (optional) the opportunity to immerse yourself in the Holy Water where John had baptized Jesus.

From Tiberias you will travel to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus, where you will visit the Nazareth Great Basilica of the Annunciation and Joseph's work shop, Mary's well and Mount Precipice. Continue to Cana, site of the first miracle where our Lord converted water to wine. Then continue via Mount Tabor to visit the Transfiguration. Finally you arrive at the Sea Of Galilee where we will visit the village of Capernaum, see St. Peter's house and the beautiful "white" Synagogue. You will also visit Tabgha the site of the feeding of the multitude. You will end your day with a boat ride on the Sea Of Galilee.

This morning you will leave Tiberias continue to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah hid from King Ahab and also fought the 400 false Baal Prophets. Then onto Stella Maris and the Carmelite Monastery housing Prophet Elijah's cave where you will stop by the view point overlooking the amazing Bahai Gardens. Continue through the Jezreal Valley to Megiddo, where archaeologists have unearthed 20 levels of civilization. Megiddo is also known as Biblical Armageddon. Continue along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea, where gentiles first heard the Good News from the Roman Amphitheatre and aqueduct!
